



CPSBB is a partner in the project "Science and Journalism: Together Against Infodemic", funded by the Active Citizens Bulgaria under the EEA FM 2014 - 2021. The project coordinator is the Association of European Journalists - Bulgaria and partners: NORSENSUS MEDIAFORUM - Norway, Thracian University - Stara Zagora, Association for Training and Career Development - Plovdiv.

The project aims to increase trust in the media and science by creating better and more in-depth content. The new reality has helped to harden even more the need not just for freedom of speech, but for media literacy, adherence to the scientific approach and facts. The situation of substituting reality, described as post-truth or "alternative facts", fundamentally undermines civil society. For this reason, we believe that enhanced cooperation between journalists and scientists is particularly needed, which will benefit society as a whole.

Within the project, two digital and other educational tools for civil education and media literacy will be developed and disseminated - a specialized platform and methodology for fact-finding training and communication for journalists and researchers. There are four initiatives to support media literacy and civil education in the form of training in different cities of the country.
